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#### CHESTNUT CLASS NEWS



This week our theme book is "**The Tiger Who Came to Tea**". The children have had lots of fun making tigers using lentils for the body and black strips of paper for the stripes. They have also been practising retelling the story using picture cards from the book.



#### WILLOW CLASS NEWS

In Willow Class, the children have been enjoying our new theme: "On the Farm". In English, they have been learning to follow instructions whilst making pumpkin soup and bread rolls. They have been describing the Little Red Hen and writing questions. In Science, the children have been learning about animals. They have learnt about the different groups of animals and how to compare them. They have also been labelling animal's body parts. In Maths Y1 have been partitioning 5 and YR have been making 4 in different ways.

#### SYCAMORE CLASS NEWS



Sycamore class have restarted term well. We are continuing our theme "Into the Woods". In outdoor learning, we are learning about living things and their habitats. We have been learning about habitats and microhabitats and the animals that live within them. We have carried out surveys and will use this data in our computing lessons. In English, we are writing a biography about Beatrix Potter. The children are using all the writing skills they have learnt. In maths, Y2 are focussing on addition and subtraction, whilst Y3 are learning their timetables.

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#### **Baby and Toddler Group**




