### DEAR PARENTS/CARERS

14th February 2019

It is incredible to think that we are nearly at the half-term mark! This term has really flow by, despite the many illnesses we have endured as a school. On that note, I would like to thank you all for your vigilance in keeping the children at home if they have had illness; it has helped.

I want to take this opportunity to ask for your considered action regarding your children's use of their mobile phones, tablets or other devices if they have them. We work very hard in school on internet safety and staying safe online. We teach the children as part of their computing education, about the importance of not giving out passwords and personal data. In school, the children's understanding and responses to questions relating to this is very good. We also talk about the importance of safe and sensible usage of mobile phone when getting involved in chat groups or when messaging. Again, in school the children are able to talk about safe and sensible use of appropriate social media. However, it is becoming more and more common for children, not just at our school, to 'forget' these safety rules and teaching when they are outside of school. We do not allow children to bring their mobile devices to school or to have them on the school premises; we expect children to communicate through talking to each other. However, we know that when at home they may be using their mobile devices quite a bit! I would encourage you to monitor carefully what your children are doing with their devices including: how and who they are messaging; which social media platforms they are accessing and APPs they are putting on their phones. Regularly sitting with your child and looking with them at the messages they are sending and other things on their phones will soon help them to put into practice what is being taught and enable you to be very aware of how they are using their devices.

We are currently working with the School Beat Officer, PC Greg Steer, on a programme that will enhance our current internet and e-safety work, and reinforce our teaching on appropriate use of ICT. This will include use of age-appropriate social media sites and being part of group-chats. Thank you for your help with this.


This week Class 2 have looked at some famous pirates. We researched Anne Bonny, Black
