<b>Summary of main barriers to learning for children eligible for Pupil Premium</b>	Retention and application of skills primarily in reading and writing. Low self-esteem and difficulties with social and emotional skills. Time in school.
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Pupil Premium Allocation for 2020 -2021 will be £2798 + £1380 brought forward = £4,178

Specific 1:1 and group Intervention	£2690	Deployment of Specific support for children who need additional support through published and bespoke interventions.	1:1 and small group intervention will give additional support to vulnerable children, enabling them to make greater progress and close the attainment gap between them and their peers. Support programmes may include, but are not exclusive to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fizzy programme (Physical development)</li><li>• Word Wasp (Literacy)</li><li>• Power of 2 (Numeracy)</li><li>• ELSA (Emotional and mental well-being)</li><li>• Handwriting (literacy)</li></ul> Children to be able to engage appropriately in lessons and activities outside the classroom, enabling them to reach their full potential and develop self-confidence.  Additional adults in school during lockdown, allowing vulnerable children to be school as much as safely possible.
