Introduction

Through considering our school Christian vision and values, as well as the needs of all our pupils at Westbury-on-Severn CE Primary School, we have developed a remote learning program to enable children to engage with the school routine if they cannot be in the school building. This has been carefully developed to encompass all areas of curriculum and to meet the national guidelines for remote learning set out by the Government. Our approach is to enable remote learning to support us in our fulfilment of our Christian vision, which seeks to ensure that all children may flourish.

In some circumstances remote learning might include live lessons, meaning that children can have real time contact with school staff both in the delivery and also to support their remote learning needs in general.

In provide consent, you will be agreeing to your child communicating with school using a device such as a laptop, computer, or tablet to video conference at agreed times from your home. All communications take place through school approved systems and are fully compliant with GDPR and safeguarding requirements.

Our school has in place a remote learning policy. A copy of this policy is available on our school website or by request. Appendix 1 of this policy sets out the specific arrangements and expectations for our school.
