Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to you to appeal for new parents to take over from myself as Chair and Lydia Redding as Secretary on the Friends of Westbury School (PTA) Committee in September. Kerry Jones will be continuing as Treasurer.

I am sure you will agree that our children experience many benefits and enjoyment from the events organised by the Friends of Westbury School and from the contributions to the school by money raised at those events. For example, this school year we have organised a successful Christmas Craft Fair, the fabulous Westbury's Got Talent show, a school disco, a Stargazing Evening and refreshments and support for Theme Celebrations and the Nativity. We are also helping with the school's production of The Wizard of Oz and will be putting on a barbeque at the end of term celebration. In terms of money raised, so far this academic year, we have raised over £3000 and have given £1000 to the school Governors for capital projects, £1600 towards School trips & Theme based projects and a new carpet and audio equipment in Class 1. Lydia and I both have children leaving the school this September or in the next few years and as we have been involved in the Committee for two years or more, we have decided it is now time for us to step down and let some new parents take over. (We will still be around to offer a helping hand though).
