Class 1 has had a fun first week back! In maths we have been learning about 2D shapes. We are enjoying

learning in our new theme, Food Glorious Food. We have focussed on the book Oliver's Fruit Salad, Year 1's have written character descriptions and reception children have been matching



initial sounds to fruit. We also made our own fruit salad, we carefully chopped up the fruit, mixed it together and all had a try, most of us thought it was delicious! Y1's then wrote instructions on how to make a fruit salad.

In Class 2 this week we have been investigating where
