UPDATED COVID GUIDANCE

There has been new guidance released regarding PCR tests following a positive Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test with no symptoms. Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive LFD test result are to be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January. This will mean that anyone who receives a positive LFD test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test. If you have symptoms you will still need to book a PCR test.
