#### NUTS IN SCHOOL

We would very much appreciate your help in the following matter. We have always tried to discourage raw nuts from being brought into school. This is because of the potential hazard that they might cause to those children who may have an allergy towards them. However, we need to extend this request to **raw nuts, hazelnuts and Nutella (or alternative make)** Chocolate spread sandwiches. Nutella contains hazelnuts, which can be harmful to some children. We would ask that you do not send your child into school with this as a sandwich filler. In addition, chocolate bars or bars containing nuts should also not be brought into school. Thank you very much for your help with this. It will help to keep our children safe as they lunch together.
