Week beginning 11/1/21

If you have any problems with google classroom your parents can contact school, and email the work in for this week.

Week beginning 18/1/21
All learning will be put onto google classroom and we will be expecting you to upload your finished work on here too. Live lessons will continue from the week before.

## Weekly plan

Monday - You'll have you spellings and vocabulary sent, there will be a maths challange and then you'll have Wellbeing, French or PE sent out depending on which year group you're in.

Tuesday - You'll have a literacy lesson to go through, this may be a video powerpoint or task to complete. There will be a live Numeracy session over Zoom for each of your year groups, we will share the sheet over the screen so you wont need to worry about them, you'll just need something to write on. Y4-11.30am, Y5-11 am (Mrs RB), Y6 - 11 am (Mrs McC). We will send home MOTs for you to work through after / before your lesson. Your final piece of work will be a theme task this will be a research task or powerpoint.

Wednesday - Same as Tuesday
Thursday - Same and Tuesday and Wednesday apart from time change for numeracy. Y6-11am, Y5-11.15 Y4-11.30.

Friday - The morning will be a spelling test, we then want you to send in some feedback for 'Feedback Friday!' by letting us know three things you've learnt and
one thing you want to learn more about. There will be a computing and art session this will be a powerpoint or a task on google classroom. The afternoon will be a PE challenge from Mr Knight. In the afternoon we will be checking the work that has been sent in, and giving you feedback. We will also be giving parents a ring if you've not handed in your work!

## Accounts

Read theory - This is currently not working, but as we have so much else going on please don' $\dagger$ worry about it, we won't be using it any more.

Khan Academy, and Times table rockstars - These were really useful last lock down but we have lots more for you to actually do now (as the curriculm is back on). Use these and other sites like them, if you need something to quietly fill your time. (Y4s we're having a little bit of an issue with your log ins, we'll email out your new ones)

Google classroom - This is really important that you can use it! Don't panic, we're still learning too and have had as much practice as you on it. That's why we're introducing it slowly. Make sure you can log on to it, and have a go at uploading your work as soon as possible so we can find any problems.

All adults are in school, but we are busy teaching the children who are in. We will be checking comments and emails at lunch time and at 3pm. This is when we will check the work sent in and log who has completed tasks. If you have any problems or worrys then we will get back to you ASAP, but if everything is hunky-dory then we'll give you feedback on a Friday and speak to you during the Zooms.
